

Speech-Language Pathologist Assistant (SLPA)

- Provide direct therapy to students of various ages with speech-language disorders under the supervision of a licensed SLP, in both individual and group settings, including community preschool environments as needed.
- Collect and document data on student progress during speech sessions to inform treatment planning.
- Collaborate with the supervising SLP on lesson planning and monitor progress toward students' IEP goals and objectives.
- Conduct Medicaid billing in compliance with district and state requirements.
- Prepare, organize, and maintain therapy materials to support effective instruction.
- Assist with student arrival and dismissal procedures as needed.
